The field of equine-assisted interventions is very unique. Professionals in this field require specific technical training and ongoing education to meet the needs of the vulnerable population with whom they work. This conference will provide industry professionals with a rare intensive opportunity to gain invaluable training and capacity development in this highly specialized sector. The knowledge and skills developed at this event will be exported by attendees to CanTRA centres across Canada, definitively improving the front-line equine -based services delivered in dozens of communities. This professional enrichment will directly benefit the thousands of persons with disabilities who take part in CanTRA programs across Canada.

Established in 1980, CanTRA creates and maintains service delivery standards and best practices for member centres across Canada, including facility accreditation and instructor certification. Mount View Special Riding Association is the host centre for the CanTRA 2020 National Conference which takes place May 29th-31st, 2020 in Olds, Alberta. This conference celebrates CanTRA's 40th year of certification, accreditation, and leadership in the field of Therapeutic Riding. This conference will bring together representatives and professionals specializing in therapeutic riding and equine-assisted activities in a unique, intensive educational event.

As the Host Centre MVSRA is responsible to provide for the presentations horses, volunteers, potentially riders. There is also a need for a "barn coordinator" but we have one volunteer already for this position. As well, volunteers will be needed for additional tasks such as:

- speaker and delegate transportation from the Calgary airport to Olds (we may schedule a bus to return everyone to the airport at the end of the conference?)
- Potentially transport delegates with limited mobility between the Pomeroy Hotel and the Arena at the College for presentations.
- The small "market place" tables with CanTRA office staff on Saturday evening.
- Silent Auction support to CanTRA office staff on Saturday evening.
- Coordinate with the CanTRA office to promote the event with the local paper(s) and other online options.
- Potentially someone to work with the professional photographer to ensure the photos needed are taken—checklist to be provided by CanTRA and may be at different times over the weekend.
- Someone to help with MVSRA risk management assessment, our annual 5 year assessment. This is separate from the conference but since a number of CanTRA qualified people will be attending it is logical to have this occur.
